### CHANGING THE LIVESEARCHCONTAINER POSITION

Depending in which column the search portlet is going to be placed you may need to change the `livesearchContainer`'s position.

If you want the search portlet to be in the left column then first go in the `public.css` from your skin,

- `ploneCustom.css`
- `portlet_search`
- `portlets.css`
- `public.css`
- `user.gif`

and then to the `livesearchContainer` class. There change the `'right:0px'` to `'left:0px'` (see image below)
